#### **SUITCASE VS BACKPACK**

# **General tips**



- Shop carefully for your suitcase of backpack –
  make sure YOU like it
- · Test them put some weights in it to test, put on shoulders, and on one shoulder, roll it around
- · Ask questions if you're unsure, it pays to know your luggage inside out

## **Pros and cons**

- + Sturdy and rigid
- + Roomy and compartment is easily accessible
- Cannot be compressed
- Not adapted for all travels

#### **BACKPACK**

## **Pros and cons**



- + Easily compressible
- + Can be used in most types of travel
- Depending on the model, content might not be as easy to get to in the main compartment
- If the backpack is judged too big, airport staff might get you to have it checked

#### **TOILETERIES**



- ·Leave soap, shampoo and conditioner at home; take the ones from the hotel
- · Bring what you really need band aids, antacids, hairbrush, etc.
- · Avoid using a big toiletry bag with a single pocket
- · Use a bag that fold flat and that has compartments, with a hook on one end

# **Rolling clothes pros/cons**

- + Does not take a lot of room
- + Rolled clothes can be put in pattern to fit space
- Clothes will get wrinkled
- It's easy to get all the clothes in a jumble after taking them out and putting them back



# **Packing cubes pros/cons**

- + Mutiple sizes to fit and separate different types of clothes
- + Clothes do not get wrinkled as easily
- Using them in backpacks can be awkward, as they may have to bend to fit its shape
- You will pack less than with the rolling method





- ·Keep in mind the trip you are taking when packing
- · Ditch single-use items, unless you REALLY need them
- · Find clothes that are not for a single purpose
- · For ladies, a pareo has multiple uses
- · Have clothes that can easily mix and match
- · Use a waterproof jacket with a warm underlayer
- · Try to use shoes that fit for most setting

## **NEED**





- · Always factor your needs when packing
- · Make the difficult decisions and be ruthless
- · Always bring the truly needed
- · Be honest: do you really really need it?
- · Decisions depend on space, trip or own criteria
- · Avoid having a "what if" category!
- · You may leave things that you'd usually bring
- · If you've asked "why did I ever bring this?" leave it

- · Travelling with only a carry on is not for everyone
- · Try it at least once, see how time and money can be saved
- · You will have limited choice in clothes
- · You can also be limited souvenir space
- · Start with a small trip
